Know Your License Code

Keep it handy, label your computer, and use the license lookup tool on the Darkroom Suppor site (link below)

Track Your Maintenance Plan

Stay current to keep software updates, Darkroom Phone, and Darkroom Email working and acess to tech support. Renew before it expires.

Manage Disk Space

Always keep at least 10% of your hard drive free. Events need room to run smoothly.

Create a New Event for Every Job

Don't reuse old events. Save and back up, then delete when done.

Pack Backup Equipment

Extra cables, camera, printer, and even a spare computer can save the day.

Test with Actual Event Gear

Extra cables, camera, printer, and even a spare computer can save the day.

Know Your Equipment

Practice with your gear so you can troubleshoot confidently.

Save Output and Copy Originals

Enable both for redundancy, and use a cloudsynced folder for best results.

Keep it Simple

Don't overcommit to complex setups unless you're confident. Under-promise, over-deliver.

Expand Your Knowledge
